

9/14/2007 - INTERNATIONAL REGATTA OPEN 5.00



After the first day of races for the class 5.00, the firsts are all French crews. Today there has been a good 5-6 mt "Ora" for the whole afternoon. Tomorrow the long distance race Torbole - Gargnano - Torbole. Start at 8.30 am. Torbole sul Garda, Friday 14 September 2007 - The French boat with skipper Christophe Heurtault and crew Arnaud Drouet is the first of the day in the International Open 5.00 class. One first and two second places have been enough to place them before the French Hervouet-Hervouet (sixth in the first race) and Buffiere-Buffiere (three times third in the three races).

Tomorrow, Saturday, there will be a "Long Distance" race from Torbole to Gargnano and viceversa. In Gargnano there will be a lunch at the local club. It means that the boats will start in the morning with north wind "Pelèr" and will come back in the early afternoon with the South wind "Ora". the score of this race will be considered apart from the general one. The regatta itself will have 6 races (3 on Friday and 3 on Sunday). The Gala dinner for all crews will be held before scheduled. That is this evening, Friday, on the Club's terrace because tomorrow the long distance race can finish too late. Sunday the first start is scheduled at 1 pm. This the provisional score after three races before the protests: 1. Hertault-Drouet (FRA - 1.2.2), 2. Hervouet-Hervouet (FRA - 6.1.1), 3. Buffiere-Buffiere (FRA - 3.3.3).
